

### 2312 CLASS SIZE

It will be the Board's goal to maintain an average class size of approximately twenty-five pupils. Achieving this goal will be dependent upon the enrollment characteristics and financial ability of the school district.

The Superintendent will work with the Principals to establish a reasonable and equitable enrollment for each classroom so that the most effective teaching can occur.

In grades Kindergarten and first, the Board endorses an optimal class size of eighteen to twenty pupils.

The Superintendent shall recommend for Board approval the number of class sections for each course or grade level. He/she shall take into consideration such factors as pupil needs, curriculum requirements, types of instructional settings, district finances and space or equipment limitations.
