

5820 STUDENT GOVERNMENT

Pupils have the right to an elected and representative student government. Student government representatives will share in the formation of general school policies, discuss matters of faculty/pupil relations, and other matters of pupil concern.

Pupils have the responsibility to participate actively in the student government process, to make sure that all pupils are allowed to vote, and that offices are open to all who qualify. Pupils may be invited to school meetings by the administrator conducting the meeting.
