**JOB GOAL:**

To provide support services inherent to the effective operation of the school media center under the direction of the media specialist.

**PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Shelves library materials.
2. Handles library mail and types correspondence and reports.
3. Processes new books, magazines, and other media materials. Catalogs and files learning materials.
4. Distributes schedule of the use of the media center and its materials and equipment.
5. Assists in preparing and maintaining special educational displays.
6. Operates the circulation desk, maintains circulation files and handles overdue library loans.
7. Repairs library materials as necessary.
8. Duplicates learning materials as requested.
9. Performs other related duties as assigned.
