Meal Prices: Elementary and Middle School will be held at 2008 pricing:

Deane Porter Elementary lunch price - \$3.50

Forrestdale Middle School lunch prices – \$4.25 - \$4.75

We will endeavor to have students try all components of the meals: side vegetables, fruits, milk. Please encourage your child to make their meal a balanced one.

Milk: Milk is available with all meals. Additional 8 oz. cartons are \$.50

Meal bundling, like soup and sandwich duos, and other "specials" offers will be trialed throughout the year.

We will be working with administrators, students, and parents to gain insight to how we can enhance our services. **To provide valuable information to everyone, paper copies of September Menu will go home with all students K-8.** After that **Menus and Nutritional Information will be available on the Rumson School District website.**

Forrestdale Program

We understand that older students have a more sophisticated pallet, so we offer some appropriate enhancements to meet their needs. Some highlights:

- Homemade “pizzeria style” round pre-sliced pizzas and calzones
- Premium Lunches – upscale food choices.

☞ **Please note that we try to be very flexible in our offerings i.e. if we have chicken as a hot meal feature it can be added to a salad; if it’s Italian Day we can take the meatballs and create a hot hero. Students shouldn’t be afraid to ask for “something different.”**

Balanced Choices Program: featured at both schools! Our goal is to *nourish* our students. With this in mind, we have developed “*Balanced Choices*”, our signature program that identifies “better for you” meals, snack and beverage choices. These will be identified by our Balanced Choices logo on menus and at points of service in the cafeteria. This program will be introduced at the start of the school year in all schools.

Other Important Information:

Each student will be assigned a PIN number so that they can access their own lunch account. Parents may pre-pay lunches by sending in cash or a check which can be applied to that student account. You may also use our on-line system, MealPay Plus, which allows the use of credit cards or automatic deposits.
