Part-Time Clinical/School Social Worker and/or School Psychologist

The Rumson School District is seeking a dynamic part-time Clinical/School Social Worker and/or School Psychologist for the 2020-2021 school year.

Qualified candidates must have:

- Minimum Requirement: NJDOE Educational Services Certificate as a School Psychologist and/or School Social Worker; LCSW (highly preferred)
- Must be able to provide direct clinical services to students and their families in an interdisciplinary team approach
- Prior experience working within context of school environment; Ability to conduct psycho-educational evaluations preferred
- Responsibilities include but are not limited to: providing psychotherapeutic counseling with individuals, family or groups as needed, collaborating with an interdisciplinary team, managing complex student plans, building and maintaining relationships with internal/external resources, making referrals to community agencies
- Must understand all stages of growth and development to assess each student's age specific needs to provide individual program plans to support social-emotional growth within the context of school environment
- The Clinical/School Social Worker and/or School Psychologist needs experience assisting students and their families to achieve the goals agreed upon as it relates to a students psychosocial needs
- As a member of the multidisciplinary team, the Clinical/School Social Worker and/or School Psychologist must be able to engage in specific assessments or interventions as part of the students plan, assist with the coordination of services and engage with the student in various settings such as their classroom and home.
- The Clinical/School Social Worker and/or School Psychologist must be able to consult and collaborate not only with the students in-district team but also with other external agencies and community resources to secure support services, and provide ongoing monitoring of student involvement, participation and compliance with individualized plans and goals as needed
- Engages assigned high-risk students in any setting based upon the needs and agreed to goals within the individualized plans
- Researches, evaluates, secures, or refers for appropriate services or placement
- Conducts case reviews to develop or update plans for target student populations in collaboration with interdisciplinary team and other service providers
- Must be able to analyze all student information collected to determine student's needs and consequent services

- Must be able to serve as a liaison to classroom teachers, paraprofessionals, community resources and related service providers
- Strong clinical skills
- Strong interpersonal skills, ability to collaborate and solicit/monitor additional supports
- Flexibility in servicing student/family across office, classroom & home settings
- Ability to conduct assessments & specific interventions (per BIP)
- Exceptional verbal and written communication skills
- Criminal History, Medical, and Child Protective Measures review approval
