Dear Parents / Guardians,

Over the latter part of the 2018-2019 school year, teachers and administrators worked collaboratively to revise the 5-8 district grading policies and regulations. Revisions were made to ensure consistency in grading practices across grade levels and subject areas.

In addition, the number of reporting periods has been reduced from four marking periods to three trimesters. This will allow for additional time within reporting periods to collect student learning evidence and monitor developmental growth, accuracy and consistency in the reporting of student growth. I will also provide a clearer picture of student progress at different points in the school year.

These will provide parents with information regarding how to interpret their child’s progress as indicated on each report card throughout the school year.
