PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Assists disabled students in getting on and off the bus and in supervising special education students while being transported.
- 2. Provides instruction to assigned students regarding passenger safety and ensures that students wear their seat belts when the bus is so equipped.
- 3. Participates in scheduled emergency bus exit drills.
- 4. Checks to be sure that assigned students are dropped off at their correct location.
- 5. Informs Supervisor of Special Education of any needs or concerns of assigned students being transported.
