Dress Code

R 5511 DRESS CODE

Below is a series of guidelines that provide our students with clear expectations for the Dress Code:

- Clothing must not reveal undergarments, undergarments may not be visible at any time during school, inclusive of see through materials.
- Dresses, skirts, skorts, and shorts must not reveal undergarments and must cover bottoms. Shorts must be visible when wearing oversized tops.
- Clothing printed with offensive slogans, references to drugs, alcohol, and/or violence is not permitted.
- Unless deemed appropriate by an administrator, hats, hoods, and other headgear are not to be worn indoors. Student faces and ears are to be visible.
- Shirts and dresses must have fabric on the front, back, and sides.
- Students may not wear outdoor coats indoors during the school day without permission.

Interventions and Consequences:

A student in violation of dress code may be asked to change clothes or have a parent bring a change of clothes. There will be consequences imposed if there is a pattern to dress code violations.
