5516 STUDENT CELLULAR DEVICES

Students are permitted, but not encouraged, to bring cellular phones and other cellular devices to school. However,

- 1. Students must completely turn off the device upon entering the school.
- 2. devices can be turned back on at the end of the school bell and used to communicate directly with individuals who are assisting in dismissal arrangements.
- 3. Students must keep their devices in their stowed-away backpack or locker- not on their person
 - a. Students may not receive messages during the school day and therefore will not respond until after the school day has ended.
 - b. All emergency messages to/from your child should go through the Main Office.
- 4. devices are not allowed to be used in a classroom, library, locker room, common areas, hallways, cafeteria, gymnasium, MPR, or restrooms.
- 5. devices are not allowed to be used during transition times, between classes or during lunch / recess.
- 6. using devices to make calls, send messages, access social media or take picture/video during school hours is strictly prohibited.
 - a. Based on the situation (ie. students' use of cell phones during the school day), the offending student may lose the privilege of bringing their device to school for a period of time to be determined by school administration.
- 7. A device used in violation of these expectations will be confiscated by a school staff member, the code of conduct will be followed and if a pattern develops, the privilege of permitting the device in school will be revoked.
- 8. if a device is used in any way to harass, intimidate, or bully another student, whether on campus during the school day or after school hours/off campus, the offending student shall lose the privilege of bringing their device to school for a period of time to be determined by school administration and a report may be made to local law enforcement.
