- 3. All target behavioral infractions are tracked by incident by our grade level team not by individual courses/teachers and continued behavioral infractions beyond Level 3/4 will result in a Code of Conduct Behavioral Action Plan at the discretion of the administration.
- 4. All target behavioral infractions that occur in the hallway, cafeteria/recess will be reported to the MO to be addressed.
- 5. Offenses of severe nature may result in a direct referral to MO.
