In New Jersey, a vehicle's engine cannot be left idling for more than three (3) consecutive minutes while the vehicle is not in motion. Violators face a fine, which doubles for repeat offenders. This law, focused on reducing air pollution and encouraging drivers to turn off their engines, applies to both gas and diesel-powered vehicles and includes exceptions for situations like traffic delays or emergency situations.

Learn to Bike!


