

POSTERS AND DISPLAYS

No posters and other display articles, other than those directly connected with curricular or in-school student activities, shall be permitted on school premises without prior approval of the superintendent of schools.

Permission for posters and display articles not related to curricular or in-school student activities may be granted if the determination is made by the superintendent that they are public service oriented and are in the best interests of the students. This may include profit-making organizations, however, the superintendent's decision will depend on the extent of the services to the students.
