Through such meetings, the staff is given an opportunity to receive and understand administrative procedures, to discuss new educational ideas, to have a forum to exchange educational findings, to become familiar with the aims and purposes of the philosophy of the schools for the continuing improvement of the education of all pupils.

The superintendent, principals, supervisor and director shall hold such meetings as are necessary to properly conduct the business of the school district.

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
