
ADMISSION

Attendance at School Free of Charge

The Rumson Public Schools shall be free to the following persons over five and under fifteen years of age:

- a. Any person who is domiciled with the school district;
- b. Any person who is kept in the home of another person domiciled within the school district and is supported by such other persons gratis as if he was were such other person's own child, upon filing by such other person with the Secretary of the Board of Education of the district, if so required by the board, a sworn statement that he is domiciled within the district and is supporting the child gratis or on a foster child bases and will assume all personal obligations for the child relative to school requirements and that he intends to keep and support he child gratuitously for a longer time than merely through the school term; provided, however, that the board of education may contest the validity of the sworn statement in proceedings before he commissioner, except that no child shall be denied admission during the pendency of any such proceedings before the commissioner.
- c. Any person for whom the bureau of children's services in the department of institutions and agencies is acting as guardian and who is placed in the district by said bureau.
