

TRANSFERS AND WITHDRAWALS

If a parent wishes to withdraw or transfer a child from school the parent will come to the school office to obtain a transfer card.

Copies of the student's records will be sent to officials of other school districts in which the pupil intends to enroll, except that the parent of a pupil will be notified of the release of mandated records and must give written consent to the release of permitted records, except in the case of students proceeding to the Rumson-Fair Haven Regional High School. Copies of records will be forwarded to the administrative official of the school within two weeks after the transfer has been verified by the Rumson School District.

Upon request parents will also be provided with a copy of the records being sent.

Early Identification of Potential Dropouts

The superintendent, in consultation with appropriate staff, shall develop criteria for the identification of potential dropouts before they reach eighth grade. The needs of such pupils shall be assessed with the purpose of determining strategies for providing them with the motivation for completing their education.
