

ORIENTATION OF BOARD MEMBERS-ELECT

The board of education wishes to make the best use of the transitional period between election and inauguration of new board members provided by New Jersey statute.

Therefore:

1. The board secretary shall ensure that all board members-elect shall be invited to attend all meetings of the board except executive sessions.
2. The board secretary shall ensure that all mailings to serving board members shall be sent to the board members-elect, including preliminary materials for all but executive sessions.
3. The board secretary shall provide each member-elect with an up-to-date district policy manual, containing policies and administrative rules.
4. The superintendent shall prepare materials to introduce board members-elect to the operating procedures of the district and the details of the curriculum.
5. Sufficient monies shall be allocated to reimburse board members-elect for expenses incurred by them in attending orientation sessions presented by the New Jersey School Boards Association, and/or the County Office or other arm of the State Department of Education, in accordance with established policies for district personnel.
